Sts PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES (Solemnity)

Psalter Week 1

Peter and Paul are the two great heroes of the Apostolic Age - Peter for leading the first Christian communities and binding them in unity, a role that springs from his profession of faith in Caesarea Philippi, and Paul for travelling throughout the Roman Empire as the Apostle to the Gentiles, ensuring that the Gospel could be heard by all. They both ended up in Rome, the heart of the Empire, where they crowned their lives of witness by shedding their blood for Christ. As the ancient hymn for this feast day ("Decora Lux aeternitatis") says: *"Rejoice, O Rome, this day; thy walls they once did sign with princely blood, who now their glory share with thee. What city's vesture glows with crimson deep as thine? What beauty else has earth that may compare with thee?"* In celebrating the death of these apostles and martyrs, we celebrate the triumph of life and death offered fully to God.

Collections

An amended Standing Order form is available for printing from the parish website. After completing the form either take it or post to your bank.

Guidance on Setting up a Standing Order

The Archdiocesan Treasurer has received a number of queries with regards to the correct name to be used when someone is setting up a standing order payment to a parish. The correct account name to use is 'Archdiocese of Cardiff' and the sort code is 20-18-23 in all circumstances. The account number is the only variable and this will be the parish account number. Problems are being experienced where parish account names are entered into the 'account name' section on the mandate. Because it needs to match exactly with the recipient account name we need to use 'Archdiocese of Cardiff' to avoid mandates being rejected.

This applies to all standing orders from now on and this situation has been verified by the bank. The use of the entity name 'Archdiocese of Cardiff' is to protect donors so that if a digit has been entered incorrectly on the account name or sort code then it would be impossible for the payment to go to an unintended recipient's bank account. Using the parish account number 73086364 ensures that the payment will go to the parish bank account, not a central Diocesan bank account. Previously only a sort code and account number were required to make a bank transfer or standing order payment.

Food Bank Collection
