CYCLE OF PRAYER FOR THE PARISHES OF THE ARCHDIOCESE: 17th SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Today we are asked to pray for Rev Timothy McGrath and the parishioners of Our Lady Star of the Sea, Porthcawl

"I am the bread of Life"

For the next five weeks, our Gospel readings take us away from our semi-continuous reading of the Gospel of St. Mark to looking at John 6, famously called the 'Bread of Life Discourse'. We will hear Jesus declaring Himself the 'Bread of Life' in the next few weeks. The Gospels over these weeks of summer prompt us to reflect upon one of the central mysteries of faith: the Most Holy Eucharist. In a time when attending Mass is anything but normal, these weeks open up before us an opportunity to rediscover what our bishops recently described as the "lifeblood of the Church". As regulations for our participation in the Eucharist continue to change here in Wales, and with another change expected within the next few weeks, reflecting upon the centrality of the Mass opens up before us the opportunity "to rediscover with new intensity the meaning of Sunday: it's mystery, its significance for Christian and human life", as St. John Paul II affirmed. Such a rediscovery of the meaning of Sundays will thus prepare us for the time when the Bishops' Conference will reintroduce to Christian life and practice the obligation of attending Sunday Mass. At this present time, the proposed date is the First Sunday of Advent (28th November 2021).

Central to the celebration of the Eucharist is the gathering together of the People of God. The parish community itself, in coming together, manifests one of the essential ways that Christ is present among us. St. John Paul II, in his 1998 document Dies Domini reflects: "Each community, gathering all its members for the "breaking of the bread", becomes the place where the mystery of the Church is concretely made present. In celebrating the Eucharist, the community opens itself to communion with the universal Church, imploring the Father to "remember the Church throughout the world" and make her grow in the unity of all the faithful with the Pope and with the Pastors of the particular Churches, until love is brought to perfection". Every person matters, every member of the Body of Christ is important, and has a unique role to play in our parish community. Let us continue to pray intensely for each other; for those who are able to gather at Our Lady's or St. David's as well as for those who are still unable to attend Mass physically at the moment and are participating in the Eucharistic celebrations via the live-stream at home.
